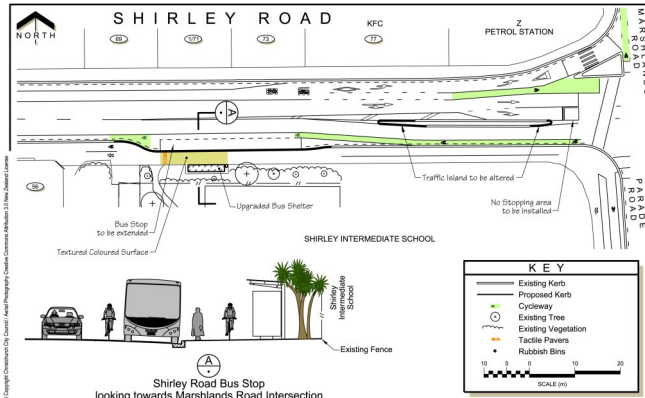

### BUILDING PROGRESSION AT SIS

For two years we have been declaring "rebuild coming"; good things take time!

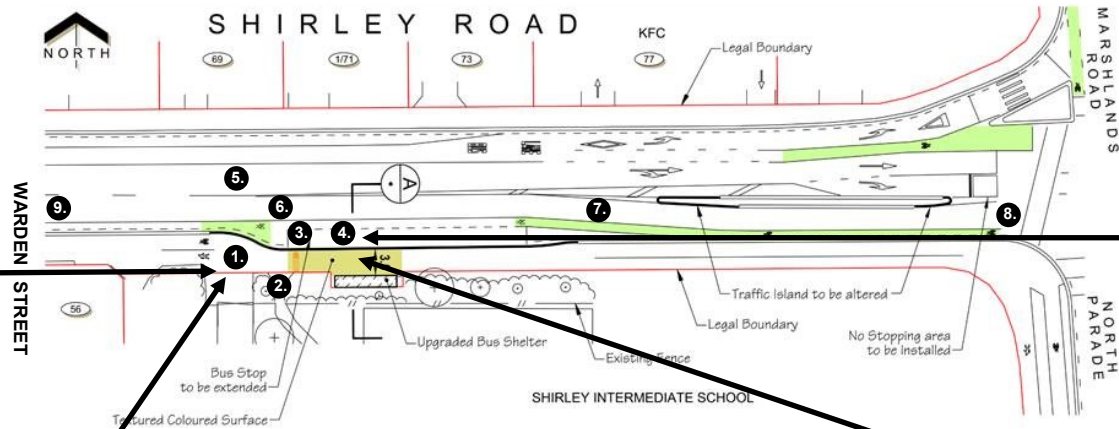
Those driving past our North Parade boundary will see that two prefabricated buildings have appeared there recently. Yes, these are the first physical sign of our new build.

#### The design of the new school includes:

- New classrooms facing Shirley Road - including a whare, "maker spaces", food room, design area and, of course, teaching spaces
- New administration and reception area accessed from Shirley Road

- Creation of two-way vehicle access from Shirley Road

- Removal of two rear classrooms and modernisation of all remaining classrooms
- Retention of school hall and adjoining rooms



- 1. New SIS Two-Way Vehicle Access
- 2. Current SIS Footpath
- 3. New Shirley Road Bus Stop (2 buses)
- 4. Current Shirley Road Bus Stop (1 bus)
- 5. Issue: Waiting to turn right into 1.
- 6. Issue: Limited line of sight with 3. bus stop and first bus pulling out, no ability to see 1. SIS vehicle access if a bus is at 3. bus stop, drivers using 1. SIS vehicle access could be turning left or right, visibility of cyclists using the on road cycle lane.
- 7. Issue: Waiting to turn right into KFC.
- 8. Issue: Red Light Runners (a. drivers turning right from New Brighton Road to Marshland Road; b. drivers turning right from Marshland Road onto Shirley Road)
- 9. Issue: Warden Street (drivers turning left nearly get rear ended due to drivers being distracted/visually overwhelmed, some students are not aware on the busy environment/don't follow road rules/check before crossing the road.)
